4. Tell us about a project, activity or cause this person has been involved in that has made a positive difference for First Nations people and/or the wider Victorian community. (Minimum 200 words)
5. What do you consider to be this person's legacy? What will be their lasting impact on First Nations communities and wider Victoria? (Minimum 200 words)

SELECTION CRITERIA:

1. Inspirational role model: demonstrates qualities that inspire both First Nations and non-First Nations people in Victoria
2. Commitment to First Nations Country, culture, lore and law: shows dedication to preserving and promoting First Nations traditions, culture and values
3. Community impact: has significantly influenced and contributed to the First Nations and/or wider community in Victoria
4. Leadership: demonstrates leadership within the First Nations and/or wider community in Victoria, resulting in positive change and enhanced community outcomes
5. Contribution to initiatives: involved in significant initiatives or engagements that have led to positive change and added value to the community.
